1.1. What does it do?

This is a gallery based on jQuery. Basically there is a thumbnail list generated on a page, and also there is a big image. When you click on a thumbnail, the big image changes according to the selected thumbnail.

You can group the images into galleries, and then you can choose which galleries you want to be displayed on the frontend.

When you add images, you have the possibility to add a title and a description (both of them changes when you change the image).

1.2. What does this plugin need to run?

1. PHP5
2. TYPO3 4.1 or higher
3. jQuery (if you don't have it already in your site, don't worry, you have an option to include it from the extension)

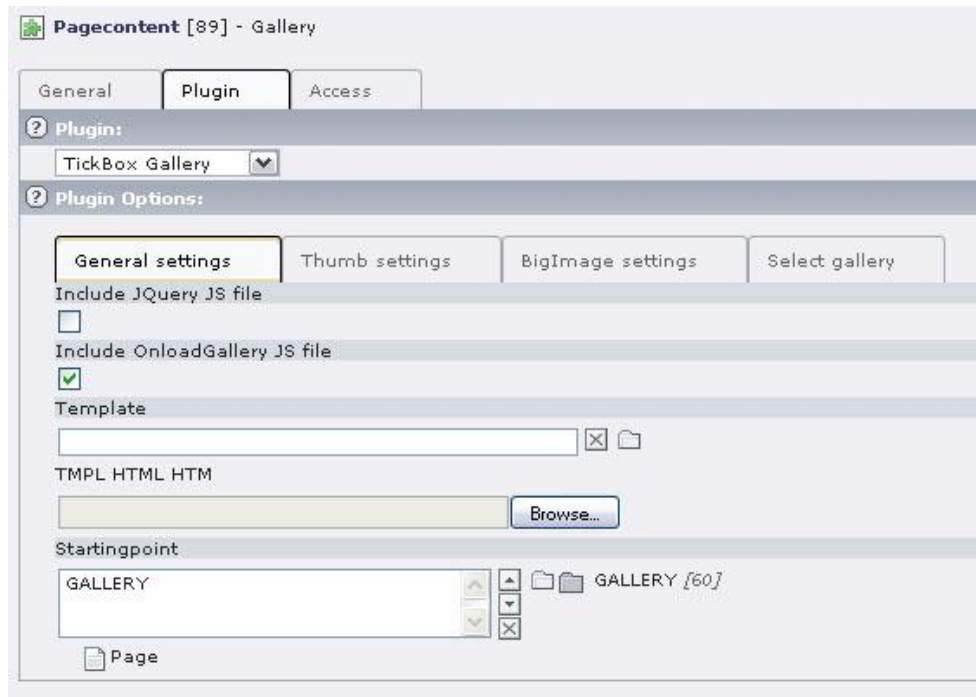

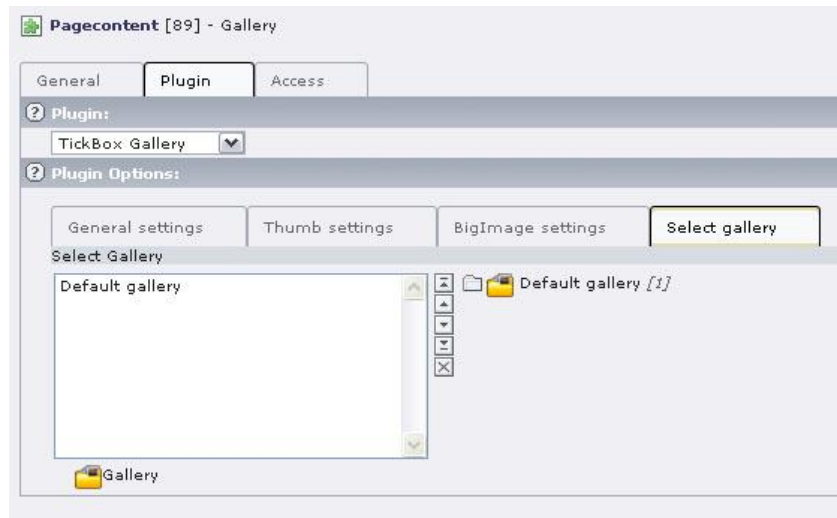
1. General setting : jQuery files, template, sysfolder

Chapter 2. Installation & Configuration

2.1.Instalation

- Import in extension manager
- Create a sysfolder where the galleries and the photos will be stored



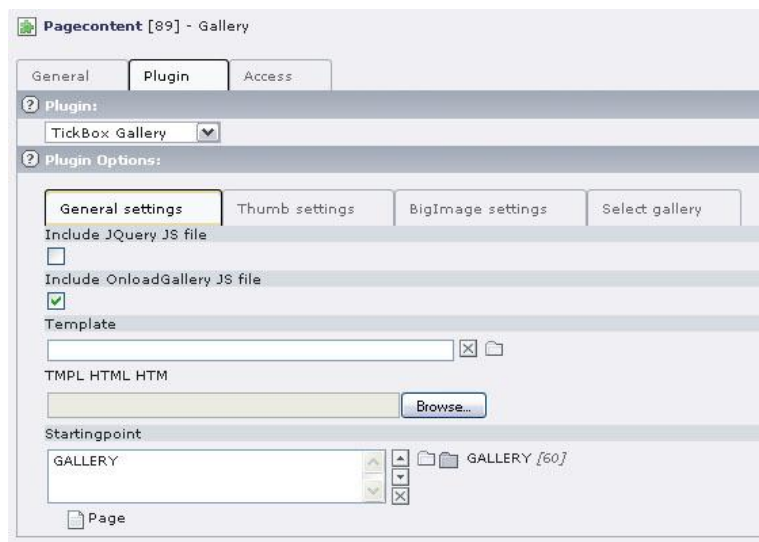
- Create a page, and insert as content element the extension



2.1.Configuration

All the configuration you will need are made from Flexform.

2.1.1. General



- The extension need the jQuery to be present. If you don't have it allready, please check the option "Include JQuery JS file". Also the extension need the option "Include OnloadGallery JS file" to be checked, or you can put the js code to any ather file that you consider.
- The extension has it's own template file, but if you want you can create your own.
- Also you have to select the sysfolder where the galleries and the photos are stored.

2.1.2. Thumb settings

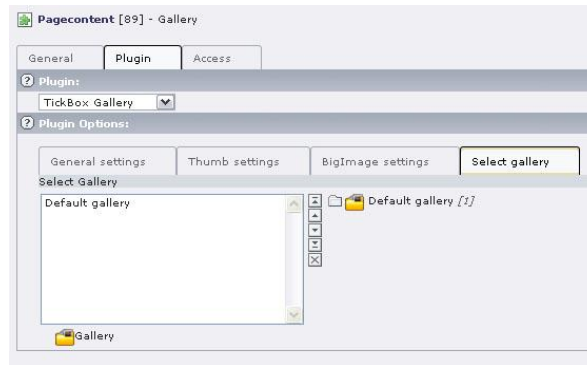
